NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Article 7, Section 23 (C) of the Louisiana Constitution and R.S. 47:1705(B) that a public hearing of the Beauregard Parish Police Jury will be held at its regular meeting place at 201 W. 2nd Street, DeRidder, LA, Tuesday, September 9, 2025 at 6:00 p.m. to consider levying additional or increased millage rates without further voter approval or adopting the adjusted millage rates after reassessment and rolling forward to rates not to exceed the prior year's maximum. The estimated amount of tax revenues to be collected in the next year from the increased millage is as follows:
